RE: Law School Parking – Proposed One-Way on Girard

The Law School is temporarily closing the student parking lot (which will hold construction equipment, not the new building as previously reported).

It is proposed that the middle block of Girard become one-way, heading south, with angle parking added. In addition, raised crosswalks and speed tables on northern and third block of Girard, and on southern and middle blocks of Kenyon are proposed.

There are discussions with UConn School of Law for possible assistance in these measures, as they are in need of on-street parking, especially while library renovations are ongoing. That is why the idea for a northbound one-way block with angle parking is on the table for Girard.

I have also e-mailed a host of questions to Kevin Burnham, City Public Works, related to various aspects of this proposed idea. I am interested in having as much information as possible at our disposal in order to foster more productive negotiations with the Law School, and with the City, too.
